Whereas, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government recognizes the need to establish broader Health and Safety Standards within the LMG commercial forestry sector;

Whereas, The LMG recognizes every employee/contractor working in the LMG commercial forestry sector has a right to work in a safe and healthy environment;

Whereas, the LMG recognizes every employee/contractor working under contract with the LMG has an obligation to work safely and to promote safety within their respective operations;

Whereas, the LMG health and safety standards require that each employee/contractor be made aware of the risks and hazards associated with harvest operations;

Be it therefore resolved, that the LMG is responsible to make known to each employee/contractor LMG's harvesting safety plan; emergency preparedness plan; and health and safety procedures to follow in case of injury, accident, fire or environmental disaster;

Be it therefore resolved, that the LMG will provide opportunities for training in safety standards to employees/contractors working in the forestry sector;

Be it therefore resolved, that in accordance with the LMG health and safety standards, each contractor will provide a list of their employees to the LMG in case of fire, emergency or accident;

Be it therefore resolved, that the LMG adopt the above as the LMG's Harvesting Safety Standards within the LMG commercial forestry sector, effective May 6th, 2015.
