Whereas, Mr. Danny Belvin is the Broker on record representing the employees of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government (LMG) for the pension plan and health and medical benefits.

Whereas, on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Mr. Belvin has informed the LMG of his intention to retire.

Whereas, Mr. Belvin had informed the LMG he was actively searching brokerage firms that would represent the LMG. Which did not produce any favorable results.

Whereas, the LMG and Mr. Belvin researched the possibility of LMG becoming a broker to represent our own employees.

Whereas, on September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017 it was determined that LMG would reach out to the two known first nation brokerage firms, RBA Financial and Thunderbird Insurance.

Whereas, on October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Chief and Council authorized LMG Human Resources to contact and request RBA Financial and Thunderbird Insurance to conduct presentations to Chief and Council and the Directors.

Whereas on October 17<sup>th</sup> and the 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017 RBA Financial and Thunderbird Insurance provided presentations respectively.

Whereas on October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, seven members who were identified as attending both presentations were asked their preference between RBA FINANCIAL and Thunderbird Insurance. The unanimous consensus was that RBA Financial was the brokerage firm of choice.


Whereas, that LMG Human Resources recommends RBA Financial to be the brokerage firm on file with our pension provider Manulife Financial and our Health and Medical Benefits Provider Sunlife Insurance.


**Therefore, be it resolved that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government:**


At a duly convened meeting of Chief and Council on November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017, to accept the recommendations of the LMG Human Resources and have RBA FINANCIAL represent the pension and the health and benefits of the employees of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government.
