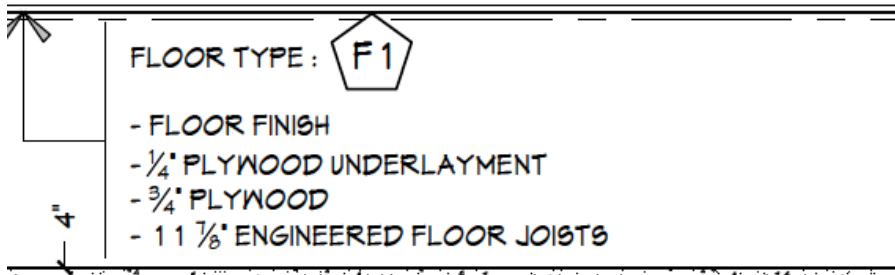

Construction of a Triplex

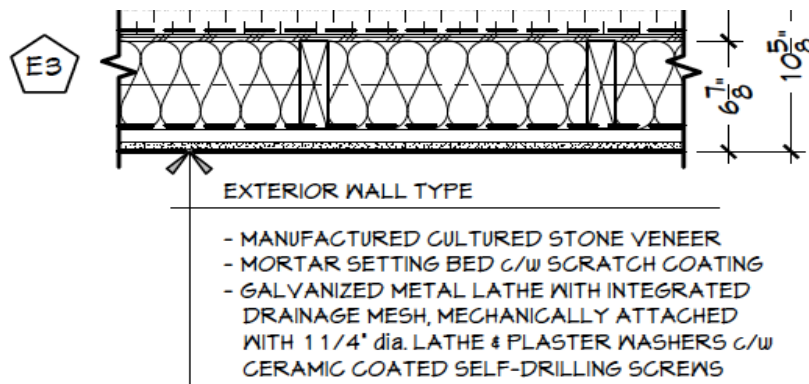

Everything is scheduled to be installed by July 1st.
2. For the subfloor is stable edge tongue and groove 3/4" okay to use in lieu of what the plans say on F1 which calls for 3/4" plywood?



Yes, stabledge tongue and groove can be used in lieu of 3/4" plywood for the floor type material

3. Are quality stone bricks which are screwed in without the need of mortar, mesh etc which are described in E3, acceptable?



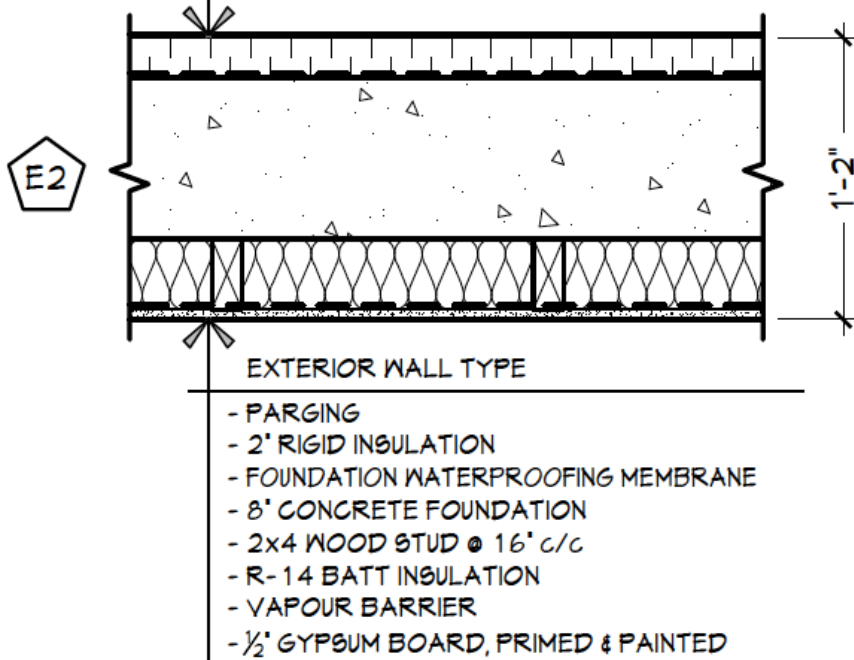
All products should be similar to the product NOVIK 233 stone.

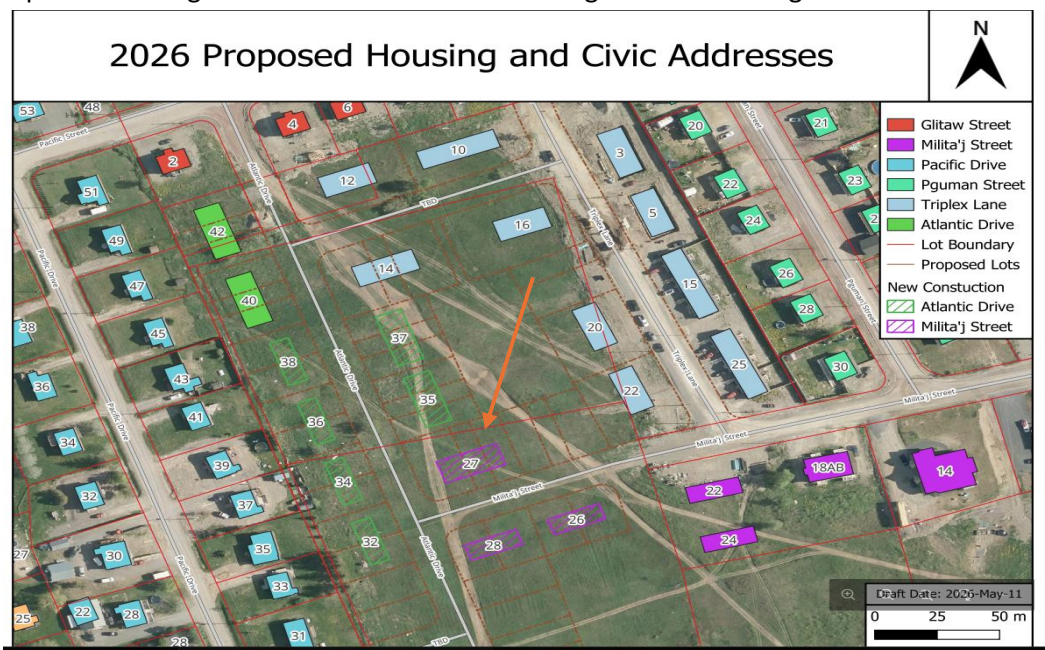

6. We need to know the distance to the underground entrance?

If the entrance is buried directly, it should be a minimum of 24 inches. If it is run in a PVC conduit, it can be at a minimum of 18 inches.
