OUTLINE:

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1. OBJECTIVE

To obtain a quote in compliance with the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government (LMG) tender policy from interested contractors; to provide the required aggregates for project construction by LMG's own workforce.

- LMG does not guarantee or commit to the purchasing of any or all aggregates.
- LMG does not guarantee or commit to the purchase of any or all aggregates from the supplier with the lowest prices.
- LMG does not guarantee or commit to purchasing any or all aggregates from one supplier.

2. PROJECTS 2026

Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is currently planning various construction projects for 2026 that require different types of aggregates:

Aggregates	Description	Estimated Amount
Pit Run	Equivalent or similar to MG112 of MTQ Standard	~670 loads
Crushed Gravel (0-¾")	Equivalent or similar to MG20 of MTQ Standard	~169 loads
Screened Gravel	Equivalent or similar to MG20 of MTQ Standard	~343 loads

3. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Upon reception, **each delivery shall be accompanied by a delivery receipt**, and a weight ticket when required:

- Delivery receipts shall be signed and collected by an LMG representative upon reception
- Delivery receipts must include the date and time of delivery
- Aggregates sold by the ton (i.e. clean stone, and rip rap) require a weight ticket upon reception
- Pit run and crushed gravel loads will randomly require weight verification and must include a weight ticket upon reception

Pit run and crushed gravel must have a minimum of 15 metric tons per load, and topsoil must have a minimum of 8 cubic meters per load.

Pricing must include material and delivery to the construction site within Listuguj.

4. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The contractor must provide proof of liability insurance for a minimum coverage of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per event.

5. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Invoicing is to be submitted weekly and must include signed copies of delivery receipts.

6. TIME AND PLACE OF SUBMISSION
