WHEREAS: the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation is a Mi'gmaq community indigenous to Gespe'gewa'gi with a sacred, inherent responsibility for the stewardship of the land, waters, and living things of Gespe'gewa'gi;

WHEREAS: one of the way the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government exercises its inherent stewardship responsibilities is through the work of the Mi'gmaq Rangers who, pursuant to the Law to Make Provision for an Aboriginal Ranger Service for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation, are "responsible for the safety and convenience of the members of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation in their harvesting activities, the preservation, management and conservation of salmon resources, other wildlife resources and natural resources generally within the Territory and the observance of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Fishing Law and other laws relating to these matters applicable within the Territory;"

WHEREAS: the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government and the Government of Québec have negotiated the Financial Assistance Agreement for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government to support its Monitoring and Protection Activities Related to Atlantic Salmon in the Restigouche River, the purpose of which to provide predictable funding for the conservation and protection activities of the Mi'gmaq Rangers in relation to Atlantic salmon from the 2026/2027 fiscal year until the 2030/2031 fiscal year;

NOW THEREFORE THE LISTUGUJ MI'GMAQ GOVERNMENT MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER-IN-COUNCIL:

- 1. The Financial Assistance Agreement for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government to support its Monitoring and Protection Activities Related to Atlantic Salmon in the Restigouche River; and
- 2. The Chief of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is directed to sign the Financial Assistance Agreement for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government to support its Monitoring and Protection Activities Related to Atlantic Salmon in the Restigouche River.

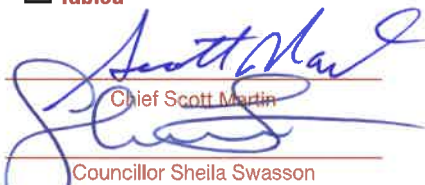
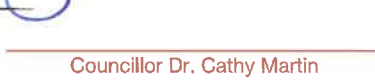
