#### 4. AFNQL and FNHRDCQ Chief meeting update

Lorna Sook discussed a summary of resolutions with the most direct impact on Listuguj: Resolution – Post 2015 Renewal of ASETS Agreement – The current Aboriginal Skills and Employment Strategy (ASETS) expires March 31, 2015. The level of funding has not changes since the signing of the first agreement in 1996.

Cathy Martin – discusses the new program FNRAEC will be hosting in January 2015; Socio Vocational – Semi Skilled trades for community members that have no work experience.

#### 5. Bomb fires - Floyd Swasson, Gisele Swasson

Floyd Swasson discussed the situation that has led him to fear for the safety of his family. He states that the harassment has been going on since 2009. It was suggested to ask Paul Stanley to review the policies and procedures of the Listuguj Police Department. Perhaps explore a bi-law to be put into place, such as trespassing.

## 6. Chief Robert Patton:

- Bill C-10 Tobacco Law
- TransCanada Pipeline
- Hunting

Chief Robert Patton, Chief Martin Leborgne and Dennis Diabo had a discussed with council regarding the Bill-C10 and how it infringes on our rights. Chief Patton also mentioned that the federal government had given their community 17 permits for the manufacture of tobacco products. After they conducted inspections and were paid taxes, they walked away leaving the Mohawks to deal with arrests and seizures by the provincial authorities. At this time Chief Patton is asking First Nations to join forces to stop Bill C-10.

Chief Robert Patton discussed with council the meeting he had with Embridge; they need to work out 115 items of concern regarding the impact of the pipeline will have in their territory.

Chief Robert Patton had a discussed with council regarding some hunters from Kahnawake that are killing too many moose than they need; then selling the meat. He says it is so disrespectful. Chief Martin explains the hunters need to ask for a letter of permission to hunt in Listuguj then a copy is sent to William Moffat, Chief of Police.

# 7. Mi'gmawei Mawiomi Secretariate - Tanya Barnaby

Tanya gave a presentation as to the process of Accommodations & Consultations.

Tanya states that she would like to have a contact person to communicate directly with—

The AANDC ratios are turning around – up 3%, from 19 million to 17 million Lease to own is problematic; we are looking into different solutions to collecting the rent due to the LMG.
