30 day Notice of Intention to Disconnect Cross Point from Waste Water Treatment Line.

The CEO of Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government Paul Stanley has issued a stern warning to Pointe a la Croix, that if they do not return to the table and act in good faith the waste water pipeline will be closed which will cause significant waste water issues to the citizens of Point a la Croix.

"We are saddened by the attitude of Point a la Croix and the deliberate stalling of the discussions with no real commitment to conclude or furthering this project" Stanley said. "the lethargy that is being displayed by the Director General on behalf of Point a la Croix is not only deliberate but also wasting taxpayer dollars" referring to the attended costs from their delays.

Pointe-a-la-Croix has deliberately and intentionally stalled negotiations to resolve this agreement via;

- Not responding to repeated requests for meetings;
- When meetings are conducted little or no constructive material is provided;
- Seeking opinions from a 3rd party and not disclosing who that third party is so that the LMG can provide all information required;
- Introducing spurious claims of a Mosquito eradication programme, this is contrary to all other official paperwork provided since 2006.

The Joint Wastewater Treatment Project has been financed solely by Listuguj since 1999 and has far more benefit for Pointe-a-la-Croix than it does for Listuguj. Refusal to pay the agreed percentage of the deal is now amounting to an excess of \$53,511.41 for fiscal 2013.

Although always open to amicably conclude negotiations of this file of nearly a decade, we will close off the valves in the pipeline on Friday March 6, 2015 at approximately 4 p.m. as the first of several incentives to conclude negotiations.
