**WHEREAS:** The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has adopted the First Nation Law on Fisheries and Fishing on July 5, 1995

**WHEREAS:** The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has adopted the Mi'gmaq Ranger Law on July 5, 1995.

**WHEREAS:** The Mi'gmaq Ranger Law states that the provision of ranger services is expedient and necessary for the safety and convenience of the members of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation and their harvesting activities, the preservation, management and conservation of salmon resources, other wildlife resources and natural resources generally and to provide for the observance of laws relating to these matters by providing effective, efficient, professional and culturally-sensitive Aboriginal Ranger services

**WHEREAS:** The Mi'gmaq Ranger Law indicates that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation Government has organized a Public Security Directorate for the purpose of fulfilling certain duties with respect to observance of law and order and the maintenance of the public peace

**WHEREAS:** The Chief and Council has expressed the importance of enforcing and supporting the said laws, and the continued development of a rangers service for the enforcement of the Mi'gmaq Fishing Law, and the possible expansion of services into other wildlife resources

**WHEREAS:** The Mi'gmaq Ranger Law outlines the training requirements, duties, standards, and code of professional ethics and conduct of officers

**WHEREAS:** The Listuguj Chief and Council recognizes the need to develop a training strategy to insure compliance with the requirements of the Mi'gmaq Ranger Law

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

**THAT:** the council hereby confirms its interest in developing a Ranger's Training Strategy, and pro-forma budget for Listuguj Rangers to be enforced by April 2019

**THAT:** the council mandates and authorizes Peter Arseneault, Director of Public Security to do all things necessary to oversee and complete the Rangers Training and to ensure implementation of this order in council
