AND, WHEREAS the safety, security, and development of all its members are paramount in their duties as the elected leadership of their First Nation;




AND, WHEREAS the member children of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation deserve and require permanent placements with opportunities to develop to their full potential;
