WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government's vision is to foster and revitalize our way of life with, and for our people; and

Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is to deliver the best possible services and programs in accordance with practices and budgets as approved by council; and

WHEREAS there exists a lack in government funding to meet and address Listuguj community members needs and thus requires the LMG to engage in viable economic initiatives in an attempt to address these shortfalls.

WHEREAS The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is desirous to create a gaming regulation to rule and govern gaming within the territory. The vision for gaming regulation is to ensure fair, equitable and controlled gaming activities that will also provide a revenue source to the community and people; and

WHEREAS the gaming regulation will put an orderly procedure that will be followed to develop the Listuguj Gaming industry consistent with Listuguj's economic plan. The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Gaming Commission will drive the process.

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government issued a "Request for Proposals" to solicit proposals from firms/companies with prior experience and expertise in the First Nation Gaming Industry.





THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has received several proposals and have examined its contents, ensured the proponents were aligned with the Mi'gmaq Vision and had the necessary credentials to undertake the work of developing a gaming regulation.

BE IT THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government accepts the proposal submitted by Dickinson Wright LLP a limited liability partnership with offices located in downtown Toronto.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED Chief Darcy Gray will act on behalf of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government to sign contracts with the project proponents. The Economic Development Unit will coordinate the work and report back to the Chief and Council on a regular basis.
