WHEREAS The Mawo'Itijig Mijjuaji'g Child Care Centre wishes to provide the children and parents of the community of Listuguj with the safest and most educational child care environment;

WHEREAS The Mawo'Itijig Mijjuaji'g Child Care Centre would like to improve on the Mi'gmaq Language Program with the children, through a curriculum designed to keep our culture alive. We would also like to enhance our program to match the Head Start program to benefit children who DO NOT attend Head Start so that they may have the same long term learning advantage that children have that attend Head Start before nursery.

WHEREAS The Mawo'Itijig Mijjuaji'g Child Care Centre requires an after school child care to their current facilities so as to meet the growing demand for child care in Listuguj.

WHEREAS The Mawo'Itijig Mijjuaji'g Child Care Centre will be submitting the attached budget in the amount of \$118,064 to the First Nations of Quebec and Labrador Health and Social Services Commission (FNQLHSSC)

WHEREAS The FNQLHSSC requires an Order-In-Council from the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government as a declaration of support for this funding proposal;
