WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has signed a special agreement with the Government of Quebec, Secretariat aux affaires autochtones (SAA) Aboriginal Initiative Fund (AIF) III, ending March 31, 2022;

WHEREAS the SAA has set aside \$1,660,000 for priority projects within the economic development component;

WHEREAS Listuguj's Economic Development Unit has identified through the Economic Development Strategy and Comprehensive Community Planning, the need to further explore tourism initiatives within the territory;

WHEREAS the Economic Development Unit intends to develop a Tourism Strategic Plan that will properly plan, develop and identify tourism projects as well as identifying partnership opportunities with public and private sectors;

WHEREAS the Tourism Strategic Plan will be achieved by carefully planning and taking into account the principles of sustainable development and to be able to achieve concrete actions that will act as a foundation for tourism, economic and social development as well as setting long-term value for our community and our neighbors;

WHEREAS the project aims to achieve the Tourism Strategic Plan by undergoing an in-depth tourism diagnostic in and around the area, to be undertaken in conjunction with a local tourism agent and tourism consultant;

WHEREAS the Economic Development Unit has submitted a project proposal to the Canada Economic Development for Quebec Regions, for a total of \$406,000;

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to set aside \$162,000 from the AIF III fund to financially assist in the development of this Strategy;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government requests the Secretariat aux affairs autochotones to reserve \$162,000 for the purpose of supporting the Listuguj Tourism Strategic Plan Development.
