WHEREAS the LMG firmly stands against these allegations and seeks to resolve this dispute;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the LMG request Indigenous Services Canada and the Library and Archives Canada provide the LMG Manager of Traditional Lands, Fred Isaac, with all documents necessary to resolve the issue of ownership of the aforementioned center strip of highway on Highway 132.
