WHEREAS LMG is in the process of restructuring its economic development activities within its organization;

WHEREAS the economic development activities fall under the Administration Directorate and is managed by the Economic Development Manager;

WHEREAS the Director of Administration is directly managing some of the businesses, such as Chipper Operations, while others are under the management of economic development manager;

WHEREAS the Council deems it useful and necessary to establish an Economic Development Directorate whose mandate shall be to look after the community economic development projects and initiatives as elaborated in the Economic Development Strategy;

WHEREAS before such a Directorate can be established and integrated into the LMG's organizational structure, the Council wishes to be informed and advised on the methods and conditions required to implement such a Directorate;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT the Council hereby mandates Donna Metallic, Vance Brisk, Delphine Metallic and Nadir André, as legal counsel, to assess the feasibility of establishing an Economic Development Directorate within LMG and to report back to Council within a reasonable timeframe with terms of references, budgets, new organizational chart and proper recommendations for the establishing of such Directorate;
