- Whereas The vision for learning and education in Listuguj is *Siawinnui'sulti'gw* *Siawimegitelsulti'gw* - *Siawignu'tmasulti'gw*;
- Whereas The Alaqsite'w Gitpu School offers a Mi'gmaq Language Immersion Program for Listuguj students attendings K4 to Grade 4;
- Whereas The Mi'gmaq Language Immersion Program includes teaching in an outdoor environment - *Nipugtugwei*;
- Whereas The Alaqsite'w Gitpu School budget for 2019/20 has allocated funds for the procurement of a prefabricated mobile classroom trailer for the *Nipugtugwei* program;
- Whereas During the Community Planning Workshop met on July 4, 2019 it was decided the Base Camp should be located within the Cultural and Tourism Area in a wooded area behind the former Busted House on Lot 4 Block VI of the Listuguj Community Master Development Plan;
- Whereas an environmental assessment of the proposed site was submitted to Indigenous Services Canada for review that was returned with an approval to proceed; and,
