WHEREAS economic and community development is a priority of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government;

WHEREAS on May 30, 2012, the Government of Québec published in La Gazette officielle du Québec Order in Council 428-2012 made on May 2, 2012, concerning approval of the creation of Aboriginal Initiatives Fund II;

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to enter into a Special Agreement with the Government of Québec with respect to the terms of application of Aboriginal Initiatives Fund II;

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government signed the *Special Agreement establishing the terms of program planning and cooperation in the economic development and community infrastructure field of the Aboriginal Initiatives Fund (AIF)* with the Secrétariat aux affaires autochtones on November 5, 2012, and that the residual amounts are still available for use by Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government;











WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to have the residual amounts transferred from AIF to AIF II, that the AIF Agreement will be resiliated and all projects assessed according to the criteria applicable under AIF II, for the economic development and community infrastructure components, the other components of AIF ending on March 31, 2012;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Council will take the measures required to enter into a Special Agreement establishing the terms of application of Aboriginal Initiatives Fund II with the Government of Québec, and mandates Frederic Vicaire to represent the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government in this regard, to contact the Secrétariat aux affaires autochtones, and to sign this Agreement on behalf of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government will request that the Secrétariat aux affaires autochtones (SAA) transfer the residual amounts from AIF to AIF II, that the AIF Agreement will thereby be resiliated, and all projects will be assessed according to the criteria applicable under AIF II, for the economic development and community infrastructure components, the other components of AIF ending on March 31, 2012.
