WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has requested a financial contribution amounting to \$253,149 to the *Secretariat aux affaires autochtones* (SAA) under the *Aboriginal Initiatives Fund* (AIF) for the Chipping Equipment Project No. 3.

WHEREAS the total cost of the project amounted to \$506,498.50 for:

- Liebherr Log Loader \$410,400.00
- Cardinal Chipper Disk \$ 82,799.50
- North Shore Welder \$ 13,299.00

WHEREAS the SAA is committed to help fund the project in accordance with the rules established in the funding agreement for a maximum amount of \$253,149.

WHEREAS the project was completed on June 10, 2013 at the satisfaction of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government.

Report

LMG has purchased all 3 new pieces of equipment which were part the SAA AIF application which was sent in 2012.

The new Liebherr log loader 934 has increased productivity and created less down time for repair. It has been operational since April 2013. The manager has noticed a significant saving on fuel consumption on this specific machine compared to the older Liebherr 924, which the LMG still, have 2.


The new larger Chipper Disk, has created stability and prevented the chipper operation to be down when there is an issue with the other set of disk. This in return, lowers the cost of operation. The large size in disk has also increased quality and production of chips and therefore is more efficient.

The portable welder will provided added help for repairs and lower the down time for repair. It will also provide instant repair solution that is need on a day to day operation for this type of activity.

The LMG Chipping employs a total of 13 Mi'gmaq Listuguj Community members with 2 employees job sharing on a 6 month basis. We have a total of 4 experienced liebherr Log Loader operators which provides an essential part of our success as a company own by Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government. We have also hired a diesel mechanic, who is from Listuguj, in order to diversify our expertise in this operation and provide lower repair cost.
