Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government (LMG) is engaged in fishing commercially since the landmark decision *Marshall* in 1999.

Whereas the LMG has been engaged in harvesting blue mussels in the Baie des Chaleurs and has licenses for three sites off Carleton-sur-Mer.

Whereas the LMG has attempted several techniques over the years to successfully harvest blue mussels and in the recent past has begun a reorganization and clean up of site 2 and 3 and a new set-up on site 1. This is a multi-year project (spat mussel to market size is approximately three years)

Whereas LMG is seeking financial assistance from the Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada through the Societe de Credit Commercial Autochotone (SOCCA) to continue the work already underway in the past three years. A business plan with full details is attached. Main work on the mussel sites incudes: continued clean-up, set up and purchase of a vessel to assist in harvesting.

Therefore, be it resolved that the LMG supports the activities contained in the business plan and are committed to ensuring the continued success of the mussel farm
