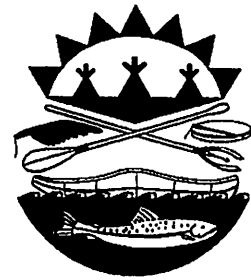


Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government Order-In-Council

WHEREAS on April 4, 2011, the representatives in assembly decided that it was important to have the FNEC represented at the First Nations School Council in Adult Education that had been established by the First Nations Human Resources Development Commission of Quebec (FNHRDC) to establish one English and one French Adult Education Centre;

WHEREAS the First Nations School Council in Adult Education had no legal basis to engage in the business required to open and operate these two centres, the FNHRDC proceeded to create a trust to meet this end;

WHEREAS the FNEC is called upon to appoint a trustee as part of establishing a trust for the First Nations School Council in Adult Education;

WHEREAS a legal opinion was requested to have a clear understanding of the implications this would have for the FNEC, and avoid any conflict between the FNEC and another party;

WHEREAS a summary of the situation and the legal opinion obtained was presented at the last general assembly, held in Odanak on June 28 and 29, 2012;

WHEREAS it was agreed that representatives would meet with their chief and band council in order to present the summary of the legal opinion, discuss the situation and make a decision;

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the member communities agree that the First Nations Education Council appoint a trustee as part of establishing a trust for the First Nations School Council in Adult Education.
