WHEREAS, the Chief and Council of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government (LMG), in the Province of Quebec, act for and on behalf of the members of the Listuguj First Nation and are empowered to exercise such powers as set out in the *Indian Act* and other applicable legislation.

WHEREAS, OIC number 1573, dated April 29, 2005, titled, Housing Selection 2005, identified Scott Ritchie, Band Number 1299 as being a recipient of a "Lease to Own" home to be situated at 7 Nation Lane (Lot 69, Block 3) in Listuguj Quebec.

WHEREAS, on or about May 23, 2013, Scott Ritchie (Band #1299) sent a letter to Chief and Council requesting that his home and all responsibility for the same be transferred to his son, Eric Barnaby (Band #2725)

WHEREAS, on or about July 1, 2006, Scott Ritchie, Band Number 1299 and the LMG executed a contract for the abovementioned home which is presently constructed at 7 Nation Lane.

WHEREAS, Scott Ritchie, as of April 1, 2014, is up to date with all of his mortgage payments as stipulated in the contract identified above, signed on July 1, 2006.












WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government will provide the Ranger Services in the designated fishing zone where the Listuguj Mi'gmaq harvest Atlantic salmon as described in the operation plan.

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government agrees to accept a one (1) year service contract with the intent to sign a long term agreement with the Ministère du Développement durable, de l'Environnement, de la Faune et des Parcs, Province of Quebec for the protection of the Restigouche River estuary.
