WHEREAS on June 11th, 1981 the community of Listuguj was raided by the Quebec Provincial Police, after a ministerial order was issued, effectively imposing a restriction on our salmon fishery; and

WHEREAS the effects of the raid on our community strengthened our collective resolve to continue fishing as we have done since time immemorial;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Chief and Council proclaim June 11th as a designated holiday in remembrance, and shall be known as "Mi'gwitetm '81".
