- WHEREAS** We, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government (LMG), strongly believe in our culture and tradition, our aboriginal and treaty rights, and most of all, our People; and
- WHEREAS** We stand by our Vision "Getlamite'tmeg enmina'qeg ugjit wejgwapegsultijig"; and
- WHEREAS** Part of our Vision is to foster and revitalize our way of life by providing quality health, social and educational facilities, as well as services for those most in need; and
- WHEREAS** It is the goal of the LMG to create a culturally relevant environment that would provide quality short and long term care for Listuguj community members who can no longer maintain their autonomous state within their own homes; and
- WHEREAS** The LMG has, for more than a decade, worked towards building a multi-care Elder's housing facility within Listuguj to support community members in need of specialized care services; and
- WHEREAS** The LMG continues to work with Indigenous Services Canada; Health Canada First Nations and Inuit Health Branch (Quebec Region); and Quebec (Gaspé / Illes des Madelines) Centre de Santé et de services sociaux to make this a reality;
- BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government reiterates its commitment to building a facility to meet these specific needs of our community; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the LMG rescinds OIC #1293 dated September 25, 2001, in which specific individuals were named to a Working Group for the Elder's Facility; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the LMG rescinds OIC #1542 dated December 9, 2004 which approved the expansion of the Elder's lodge for the provision of meals and social activities to all senior citizens 55 and older; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the LMG mandates the LMG Project Manager to proceed with the Tender Process in accordance with the LMG Financial Administration Law to construct said building; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the LMG approves the development of a new Working Group with the mandate to develop the appropriate Health and Social Programs required to meet the needs of our Elder population.
