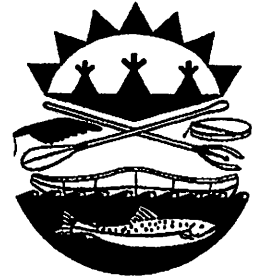


Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government Order-In-Council

WHEREAS the Natural Resources directorate of the LMG routinely upgrades its capacity for sea food extraction and has set aside a replacement fund to allow it to make purchases of a larger nature

WHEREAS the LMG fleet is in need of a crab fishing vessel and a suitable 18.26 metre wood/fiberglass boat has been identified

WHEREAS the vessel is named the "Harry Frye" (Department of Transport number 371604, registered in the Port of Caraquet, New Brunswick) and was built in 1976 with a rebuild in 2016

WHEREAS an inspection evaluation was conducted on March 9th 2020 by Marine Expert Plus Inc a Maritime Consulting company. They have indicated that the "Harry Frye" crab fishing boat is in good condition and its estimated current market value is \$375,000 CDN. Furthermore, the approximate replacement value for a similar fiberglass boat would be \$2,350,000 CDN

WHEREAS the owner of the "Harry Frye" has offered it for sale through TriNav Marine Brokerage at the price of \$275,000 CDN

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that LMG, through Natural Resources directorate, purchase the "Harry Frye" vessel and incorporate it into our fleet
