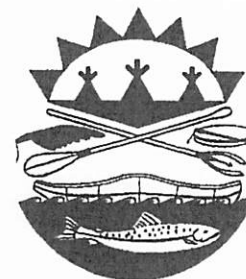


Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government Order-In-Council

WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation has declared a State of Emergency on April 6th 2020 and adopted a Unified Command structure for its Emergency Management Organization (Motion 2020.04.06)

WHEREAS there have been several incidents requiring self-isolation of individuals due to possible direct or indirect exposure to the novel coronavirus or arising from travel

WHEREAS both the Quebec and New Brunswick governments have passed legislation pursuant to the Public Health Acts requiring isolation in certain cases

WHEREAS the Unified Command prefers to use our own laws and believes that such legislation is a legitimate expression of First Nation sovereignty

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that

To avoid any risk of infection by Covid-19, the LMG health director, or the Unified Command be authorized to order a person to self-isolate for a maximum period of 14 days if the person does not consent to voluntarily self-isolate and is in any of the following situations:

- (1) the person shows Covid-19 related symptoms and there are serious reasons to believe the person has been in contact with a person who has that illness;
- (2) the person has recently lived, stayed or visited an environment in which persons having Covid-19 related vulnerability factors are also living or staying or in an environment where there is a greater risk of Covid-19 transmission, and there are serious reasons to believe the person has been in contact with a person who has that illness;
- (3) the person is living or staying in an environment in which persons having Covid-19 related vulnerability factors are also living or staying or in an environment where there is a greater risk of Covid-19 transmission, and the person shows Covid-19 related symptoms; or
- (4) the person is waiting for the results of a priority Covid-19 screening test;
- (5) the person has obtained a positive result following a Covid-19 screening test and is still considered to be contagious;

That the isolation of a person cease as soon as a negative Covid-19 screening test is obtained or the LMG Health Director, or an attending physician is of the opinion that the risks of contagion no longer exist; or that a qualified Court has so ordered
