WHEREAS: On March 25th, 2020, the government of New Brunswick announced their decision to impose restrictions at provincial borders to people from outside the province entering, as a way to deter the potential increase in risk for transmission and infection specific to COVID-19.

WHEREAS: Upon hearing of this pending decision, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government inquired about the details of the decision and publicly stated through a community announcement that this decision would be problematic.

WHEREAS: The imposed restrictions, at the checkpoint in Campbellton have become increasingly problematic over time for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government, and the people of Listuguj

WHEREAS: On May 15, 2020 a letter was sent from the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government, to both the Premieres in Quebec and New Brunswick to explore ways to address the issues, and to date no response has been provided.

WHEREAS: The imposed restrictions by the New Brunswick Government remain in effect, and no end date has been identified.

WHEREAS: The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is committed to and will continue to work in the best interest of the community and members.
