Whereas Listuguj has a vibrant entrepreneurial ecosystem existing in the community with approximately 50 businesses ranging in size of one person to ten employees; and

Whereas small business activity in Listuguj includes: forestry and fishing, construction, wholesale and retail trade, telecommunications, rentals and leasing, professional and technical services, consulting, health care, entertainment and recreation, accommodation and food services; and

Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government favors supporting entrepreneurship because of its ability to improve standards of living, not only for themselves but also for related businesses; and

Whereas entrepreneurs help drive change with innovation, produce positive outcomes for the community, and enable new markets to be developed; and

Whereas Entrepreneurs help to contribute in other ways such as investing in community projects and supporting local charities; and

Whereas The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to continue supporting small entrepreneurs because doing so increases the economic well-being of its community members; and

Whereas the Listuguj Economic Development Unit drafted the Listuguj Economic Development Initiative and will be used as the mechanisms to provide non-refundable contributions to entrepreneurs; and

Whereas the Listuguj Economic Development Initiative Guidelines are attached hereto; and

Therefore, Be It Resolved That the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government allocates \$75,000, to be administered as a non-refundable contribution and in accordance to the Listuguj Economic Development Initiative Guidelines. The Economic Development Unit will present to the Chief and Council a full report of activities, finances and new request for funding when the fund is near depletion.
