WHEREAS: Listuguj has made a request for financial assistance from Canada and Quebec for an amount not to exceed:

- thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) for fiscal year 2020-2021;
- fifty-nine thousand eight hundred and sixty dollars (\$59,860) for fiscal year 2021-2022;
- on hundred sixteen thousand two hundred and forty dollars (\$116,240) for fiscal year 2022-2023; and,
- one hundred fifteen thousand seven hundred and forty dollars (\$115,740) for fiscal year 2023 -2024;

WHEREAS: Canada and Quebec entered into a framework agreement under which the governments undertake, among other things, to coordinate their respective funding for the implementation of community-based Indigenous justice projects;

WHEREAS: Canada and Quebec agree to financially support Listuguj in carrying out the objectives set out in the contribution agreement and Listuguj's representative has been duly mandated to enter into this contribution agreement.

WHEREAS: the community justice program covered by this financial contribution agreement will foster the promotion of alternative methods of conflict resolution and address the overrepresentation of Indigenous people in the justice system through prevention, diversion and social reintegration programs, including Gladue aftercare

WHEREAS: the program's direct costs of THREE HUNDRED TWENTY SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY DOLLARS (\$326,840) shall be for the period from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2024 over the term of this contribution agreement;

THAT: LMG wishes to establish the funding by Canada and Quebec of a community-based justice program that aims to offer local services that will meet community needs, in accordance with the Indigenous Justice Program, and authorize Chief Darcy Gray to sign on behalf of the LMG for this program and managed by Mary Bradstreet Metallic through the Justice Transformation Initiative program and Interim Chief Executive Officer, Jeff Basque
