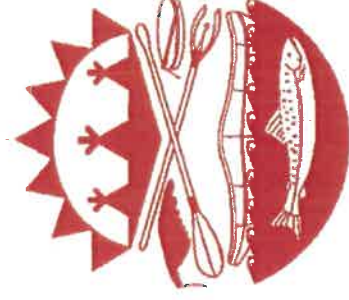

WHEREAS: Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has provided exclusive chip production services for the AV Cell Mill in Atholville, NB for 18 years and continues to bring significant revenue and employment to the Band.

WHEREAS: LMG Chipping has aging equipment and facilities which need to be replaced including log loaders, log loader trailers, grapples, front loader, chipping module and muster station/office trailer.

WHEREAS: LMG Chipping has presented a business case to the Chief and Council for financial consideration to make these acquisitions of new equipment.

WHEREAS: LMG Chipping will install and use new equipment to improve production in general, increase employee morale, reduce downtime, increase profitability, alleviate repair needs, reduce repair costs, and allow for a more concentrated effort on production management.

WHEREAS: LMG Chief and Council, upon signing of a new five (5) year service agreement with AV Cell, support the acquisition of new equipment and facilities for LMG Chipping and foresee the continuum of significant employment and for the LMG.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT: LMG Chief and Council do hereby authorize Chief Executive Officer to act as signing authority for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government respecting the new (2022 – 2027) five (5) year agreement between the LMG and AV Cell.
