WHEREAS:

- A. Hydro-Québec Distribution has initiated a request for proposals for the acquisition of 450 MW of wind energy (A/O 2013-01) (the "RFP");
- B. Innergex proposes in partnership with Régie Intermunicipale de l'énergie de la Gaspésie et des Iles-de-la-Madeleine and Énergie éolienne Bas-Saint-Laurent s.e.n.c., a new 75 to 100 MW Wind Farm to be located in the Mesgi'g Ugju's'n Wind Farm project area (the "MU2 Project");
- C. Mesgi'g Ugju's'n Limited Partnership is the owner of the 150 MW Mesgi'g Ugju's'n Wind Farm (the "MU Wind Farm"), a wind farm that is being constructed on provincial Crown land situated in the TNO Rivière-Nouvelle of the MRC Avignon, in proximity to the Gesgapegiag and Listuguj communities in the Gespe'gewa'gi territory in the Province of Quebec;
- D. To interconnect the MU2 Project to the substation of the MU Wind Farm and to use the access road to construct, operate and maintain the MU2 Project, MU Wind Farm will be requested to enter into an agreement to this effect in the event the Project is granted a PPA (Power Purchase Agreement) by Hydro-Québec Distribution;

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- E. Due to the economies of scale, savings on construction costs and turbine procurement, the MU Wind Farm benefits from a financial point of view to allow for the MU2 Project to be developed within the existing MU Wind Farm area;
- F. If the MU2 Project is awarded a PPA, the MU2 Project will provide compensation to the Mi'gmaq through an agreement that will provide long-term benefits to the communities over the life of the project (approximately 25 years).
- G. The MU2 Project has agreed to compensate the Mi'gmaq at a rate between \$10,000.00 and \$12,500.00 per MW for using the MU Wind Farm Area;
- H. The MU2 Project has agreed to provide additional financial compensation for losses to the wind generation capacity due to a compact configuration and the resulting wake effect of the MU Wind Farm through an agreement that will provide long-term benefits to the communities over the life of the project (up to 25 years).

Be it therefore resolved that:

1. The Mi'gmawei Mawiomi agrees to interconnect the MU2 Project with the MU Wind Farm.
2. The final financial compensation agreement for losses and benefits from MU2 Project will be negotiated through an agreement lead by the MMBC.
3. The MM directs the Mi'gmawei Mawiomi Secretariat and the Mi'gmawei Mawiomi Business Corporation to sign any and all agreements, contracts and other instruments needed to put this resolution in effect.
