WHEREAS on August 31, 2009, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government (LMG) informed Canada through Parks Canada, of its intent to acquire the lands of the Parks Canada National Historic Site;

WHEREAS on October 23, 2009, Parks Canada notified the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government of its pleasure to meet and begin dialogue on the matter of Listuguj acquiring the lands of the Parks Canada where the Battle of the Restigouche National Historic Site's *interpretation centre* is located;

WHEREAS on April 9, 2015, Québec City, an official meeting of representatives of Listuguj, Parks Canada, and Aboriginal Affairs took place in which substantive dialogue resulted in the agreement of creating a plan for the acquisition and addition of said lands (parts of Lot 3-11-P, and parts of Lot 1&2-4-P; see appendix 1) to the existing Listuguj Reserve lands;

WHEREAS representatives of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government agreed that the addition to Listuguj Reserve of the lands of the Canada Parks National Historic Site requires support from the Municipality of Pointe-à-la-Croix and the Province of Québec;

WHEREAS the lands of the Parks Canada National Historic Site are subject to servitudes described below:

- a) lots 3-7 and 3-11 are subject to a real and perpetual servitude of drainage of Road 132 in favour of Her Majesty in right of the Province of Québec, registered on March 11, 1983, at the Registry Office of the Registration Division of Bonaventure 2, under number 49277;
