WHEREAS:

The University of Ottawa in conjunction with Université De Montréal, and Assembly of First Nations have devised a study to investigate traditional and market food consumption patterns, identify background levels of nutrients and contaminants in the daily food and water intake of First Nations peoples living on reserve, as well as collect information on health, lifestyle, social, and economic factors that may affect the quality of nutrition or increase risk of exposure to environmental contaminants; and

The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has the best interest of the community whereby they have agreed to participate in this study by U of O, U de M, and AFN with the hope of discovering the risk level of contaminants our community is exposed to on a daily basis; and
