- Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has set employment as a priority;
- Whereas the traditional territory of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq, Gespe'gewa'gi, is rich in natural resources that includes significant hydrocarbon reserves;
- Whereas the provincial government of Quebec has adopted an energy policy and accompanying laws that supports and promotes First Nation participation in hydrocarbon industry;
- Whereas the private natural resource development companies including hydrocarbon exploration companies operating in Gespe'gewa'gi have entered into or agreed to negotiate Impact Benefits Agreements that will amongst other things provide employment opportunities for 'qualified' individuals;
- Whereas Canada has released a Call for Proposals under its Skills Partnership Fund to support and promote the training of Indigenous peoples in Canada;
- Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is intent on assisting its citizens acquire the necessary credentials to qualify for employment in the region especially in the emerging hydrocarbon industry; and,
- Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is agreeable to the Mi'gmawei Mawiomis Resource LP making financial contributions to the education and training of its citizens.
