THAT the Band Council of Listuguj agree on the terms and provisions of a draft tripartite security agreement submitted for approval to Council members;

THAT Darcy Gray, Chief of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government, and one of the other councillors be thereby duly authorized to sign for and on behalf of the Band Council of the said tripartite security agreement, as well as any other documents needed to give full effect to the Order-In-Council.
