WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is a member in good standing with the Assembly of First Nations of Quebec & Labrador (AFNQL);

AND, WHEREAS the AFNQL had recommended the organization of Mamit Innuat as a Third Party Service Provider for Patient Services in both the city of Montreal and Quebec City to Health Canada First Nations and Inuit Health Branch, Quebec Region;

AND, WHEREAS the Listuguj Community Health Services has documented a long history of unresolved issues and concerns experienced by our community members when dealing with this Third Party Service Provider;

AND; WHEREAS Health Canada has obligation, through the Non-Insured Health Benefits Program, to provide Medical Transportation to the community of Listuguj;

AND, WHEREAS the Listuguj Community Health Services has the capacity, as an Accredited First Nation Health Center, to administer the Medical Transportation Program on behalf of the Non-Insured Health Benefits Program;

AND, WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government met with the AFNQL Chief's on February 1, 2017, during which a motion was passed which stated that the communities that desired to be exempted from the obligation to use the services of Mamit Innuat could do so;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT THE Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government will exercise its right to be exempt from the Third Party Service Agreement between Health Canada First Nations and Inuit Health Branch, Quebec Region and Mamit Innuat;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government mandates the Listuguj Community Health Services to work with Health Canada First Nations and Inuit Health Branch Non-Insured Health Benefits Program to develop a process for transitioning these services and funding to the community of Listuguj.
