Whereas The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government entered into an agreement with the Quebec Government to establish the terms of the Aboriginal Initiatives Fund II in December 2012; and

Whereas, the main objective of the funds is to support Aboriginal social, economic, and community development with the main focus on providing financial support to projects with potential for major spinoffs and growth generation; and

Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is looking at various options to expand its business operations and create another revenue stream and jobs within the community of Listuguj; and

Whereas, the LMG is preparing a full business plan and market study to support the viability of establishing a seafood repackaging facility and frozen fish retail business in the community. The business plan will be used to approach financial institutions and the Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) in accessing funding, and

Whereas, the total cost of the business plan is \$269,485; and

Whereas, the LMG has submitted a project proposal to the Indigenous Affairs and Northern Development and has been approved for \$72,500 towards the development of the business plan, and

Whereas, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government will fund the remainder of the business plan costs from its own sources, in the amount of \$106,504, and

Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to utilize \$90,481 from the SAA-AIF II budget; and so,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to engage into an agreement with the Secretariat Aux Affaires Autochtones and utilize \$90,481 from the AIF envelope to complete the study; and

Therefore, be it further resolved, that Chief Darcy Gray and/or Jeff Basque, Executive Director, be mandated and authorized to sign all necessary instruments and documents to secure the funding from the Secretariat Aux Affaires Autochtones, Quebec Government.
