Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has an existing partnership with Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC);














Whereas a call for proposals was set forth by the ESDC for engaging seniors and strengthening communities with their New Horizons for Seniors Program – Community Based Projects; proposal limit of \$25 000 per community;

Whereas an advisory group, consisting of 15 Elders from Listuguj, aged 60 to 80 years, met to discuss Elder-led projects that would benefit the well-being of our Elders and community members; such as: inclusion in social activities, and mentoring through sharing of knowledge and skills;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government accepts the New Horizons Seniors Program proposal with ESDC, and authorize the Director of Social Services, Mary Bradstreet-Metallic, to manage this project and sign on behalf of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government for this initiative.
