

# Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government Order-In-Council

- Whereas** Economic and community development is a priority for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government;
- Whereas** The Government of Québec issued Order in Council n° 558-2017 regarding the establishment of AIF III on June 14, 2017;
- Whereas** The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to enter into a special agreement with the government of Québec to set the terms and conditions governing the application of AIF III;
- Whereas** The signing of the said special agreement is a prerequisite for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government's use of the funds allocated to it as part of the Economic Development component of AIF III;
- Whereas** The signing of the said special agreement is also a prerequisite for the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government's use of an amount of up to \$1 million on a "first come, first served" basis under the Community Infrastructure component;
- Whereas** Any remaining balance of funds reserved for the projects to which the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government had given priority under the Economic Development component of AIF II will automatically be transferred to the Economic Development component of AIF III;
- Whereas** If the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government could use an amount from the Community Infrastructure budget of AIF II, in whole or in part, before the special agreement for AIF III is signed, that amount could be added to the budget of the new program. The principle of "first come, first served" applies;
- Whereas** The AIF III will expire on March 31, 2022;

**It is hereby resolved that:**

The Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government take the necessary steps to enter into a special agreement with the government of Québec, setting the terms and conditions for the application of the Aboriginal Initiatives Fund III, and authorize Chief Darcy Gray to sign the said agreement on the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government's behalf.
