Whereas the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government will enter into a partnership with the Secretariat aux Affaires Autochtones, in collaboration with le Ministère de L'Éducation et de L'Enseignement Supérieur, et de la Ministère de la Sécurité Publique

Whereas the project *Program to Hire a Coordinator Responsible for Community Mobilization, Citizen Involvement and the Promotion of Healthy Lifestyles in First Nations and Inuit Communities in Quebec* and will commence in November 2017

Whereas the development of this project is realized, the expected impacts include: strengthened community mobilization in order to enhance living conditions in First Nations communities by hiring a coordinator to facilitate the mobilization approach, or participate in an existing approach and contribute to its coordination. To promote broader citizen involvement in community mobilization in local organization and outside the community by facilitating the approach. To create an environment favorable to the adoption of healthy lifestyles, especially among young people in collaboration with community mobilization and local organizations.

Whereas the guidance of a steering committee will be made available for the project to coordinate community mobilization, citizen involvement and the promotion of healthy and a round table to oversee the achievements of this projects goals and activities. The activities outlines include physical activities to take place on the territory, swimming at a local pool, fitness classes such as yoga and/Zumba, community luncheons, activity nights, healthy cooking classes, participation in the community garden and cultural gatherings. It will be the responsibility of the coordinator to work in partnership with all organizations to ensure that the outlined activities are only taking place in one place and they are not being organized by multiple committee/organizations. The coordinator will work efficiently to ensure that activities do not overlap and that we can work together as a team to ensure the best for our community.

Therefore be it resolved that the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government accept the terms of the Initiative to Hire a Coordinator Responsible for the Community Mobilization, Citizen Involvement, and the Promotion of Healthy Lifestyles in First Nation and Inuit Communities in Quebec , and authorized Director of Social Services, Mary Bradstreet Metallic to manage this project to sign on behalf of LMG for this initiative.
