WHEREAS, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government signed with the Secretariat aux affaires autochtones ("SAA") on October 13, 2017 an agreement establishing the terms of application of the Aboriginal Initiatives Fund III;

WHEREAS Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is experiencing a situation that requires the assistance of the Secretariat to undertake the expansion and modification of the youth and family care facilities, which include the Youth and Family Care Centre building, JRM Rink roof installation and playground expansion;

WHEREAS Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has given priority to improving community member's lives through recreational and physical activity;

WHEREAS Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government will help to achieve objectives of improving Listuguj community members personal health and wellness, building a safer and stronger community while promoting economic development and economic sustainability;

WHEREAS, the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government made a request to the Secretariat aux affaires autochtones by LMG Order-In-Council #2274 on December 13, 2016 to reserve funds from the capital infrastructure fund;















Whereas the total cost of the Youth and Family Care Expansion Project is now revised to \$1,449,014;

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has secured various funding sources amounting to \$130,000;

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government is committing \$279,753 from its own sources to complete the project;

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government wishes to request funding from the SAA, under Aboriginal Initiatives Fund III, via the Fund's Community Infrastructure envelope, for up to 29 % of the Project's expenses;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government authorize Chief Darcy Gray representing Listuguj to submit project proposal to the SAA under Aboriginal Initiatives Fund III and to represent the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government with different levels of government and agencies.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED THAT Chief Darcy Gray representing Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government be mandated to execute a funding request, in an amount of \$425,000, to the SAA, under the Aboriginal Initiatives Fund Community Infrastructure envelope to offset up to 29 % of the Project's expenses.
