WHEREAS: the Parties have on September 27 2022, entered into the Agreement, for a grant to the community of Listuguj for the Listuguj Police Service to carry out the reinforcement project to combat conjugal violence (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Agreement");

WHEREAS: Québec has committed to invest \$1 906 120 over four years, beginning in 2023 2024, as part of the Integrated Government Strategy to Counteract Sexual Violence, Domestic Violence and to Rebuild Trust 2022-2027, in order to support the initiatives of Indigenous police forces in providing support to victims of sexual violence and in supervising aggressors at all stages of the intervention continuum.

WHEREAS: the Parties agree on the importance of acting jointly on the issue of domestic violence and sexual violence by providing support to the victims and by increasing the monitoring of offenders and thus responding to the reports of the Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Québec: listening, reconciliation and progress (CERP) and the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls.

WHEREAS: the Council wishes to have "the reinforcement project to combat conjugal violence" implemented by the Listuguj police service in relation to the issues of domestic violence and sexual violence.

WHEREAS: the Quebec government wishes to amend the Original Agreement to include a sexual violence component.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

THAT: Chief and Council accept the amendment to add victims of sexual crimes as clientele under the existing Original Agreement.
