WHEREAS: the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government ("LMG") has established a Drinking Water Protection Law to safeguard the community's drinking water sources, which stipulates that there shall be no further housing or infrastructure development within a two-hundred (200) metre radius of the Designated Protection Areas and the main drinking water sources unless authorized via an Order-In-Council in each case;

WHEREAS: the necessity to build and replace the sanitary lift station PP-4B has been identified as a critical infrastructure requirement to ensure the proper management of wastewater and to maintain the community's health and sanitation standards;

WHEREAS: the proposed site for the sanitary lift station PP-4B is within the Designated Protection Area of the community well, requiring an exception to the Drinking Water Protection Law to proceed;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- The Chief and Council hereby grant permission for the development and replacement of the sanitary lift station PP-4B within the Designated Protection Area of the community well, as outlined in the project plan and subject to the following conditions:
 - All construction and operational activities shall adhere to the highest standards of environmental protection and risk mitigation as outlined in the approved project plan.
 - Regular monitoring and reporting of the impact on the drinking water source shall be conducted and submitted to the appropriate authorities.
 - Any deviations from the approved project plan that may impact the drinking water source shall be immediately reported and addressed in consultation with the Interim Director of Capital and Infrastructure.
- This authorization is specific to this project and does not set a precedent for future developments within the Designated Protection Areas.
- The LMG retains the right to revoke this authorization if the conditions outlined are not met or if there are unforeseen impacts on the drinking water source.
