WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government has various specific claims (the "Specific Claims") against the Crown with respect to loss of lands and resources in breach of the Crown's legal and fiduciary duties;

WHEREAS the Specific Claims notably include claims relating to the following:

1. the Restigouche River Islands, which was submitted under the federal Specific Claims Policy and accepted for negotiation by letter from Canada dated 12 February 2020;
2. the Baie des Chaleurs Railway passing through Listuguj's reserve, which was submitted under the federal Specific Claims Policy and accepted for negotiation by letter dated 9 June 2021;
3. Lots 4 and 5 in the Restigouche Range, Township of Mann, for which research funding was approved under the Specific Claims Research Program by letter from Canada dated 7 June 2023;
4. the Jigug site (Atholville) on the New Brunswick bank of the Restigouche River estuary, for which research funding was approved under the Specific Claims Research Program by letter dated 7 June 2023;z

WHEREAS the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government seeks to pursue the Specific Claims in a manner that is coordinated with its other negotiations with the Crown regarding lands, resources, treaty rights, aboriginal rights, and aboriginal title;
