WHEREAS: The Natural Resources Directorate recognizes the need for a large storage unit to haul the scallop crew's equipment to the site in one trip, thereby reducing mileage and gas consumption using multiple smaller vehicles;

WHEREAS: The scallop crew is making 4-5 trips on a daily basis to and from the Carleton wharf during scallop season from June to October;

WHEREAS: This vehicle, when not being used by the scallop crew, can also be utilized by the snow crab and lobster fisheries to haul rope and traps to the wharf, thus reducing the amount of trips for smaller vehicles;

WHEREAS: The acquisition of a cube truck will not only eliminate the recurring expenses associated with multiple smaller trips but will also ensure the availability of these resources as and when required, thereby enhancing our self-sufficiency;

WHEREAS: After thorough evaluation, the Natural Resources Directorate has obtained competitive quotes for the required equipment:

- Cube Truck Quote #1 (Ford model 14' box): \$ [REDACTED]
- Cube Truck Quote #2 (Isuzu model 20' box): \$ [REDACTED]

WHEREAS: The Treaty Related Measures ("TRM") program will fund 100% of the total acquisition cost for the Cube Truck;

WHEREAS: The Natural Resources Directorate recommends proceeding with the lowest quote (Quote #2) of \$ [REDACTED] for the Isuzu model;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Chief and Council of the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government hereby authorize the Chief Executive Officer to proceed with the Director of Natural Resources' recommendation for the acquisition of the Isuzu model 20' box Cube Truck for \$ [REDACTED]

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

The Chief Executive Officer and the Director of Natural Resources are further empowered to undertake all necessary actions to ensure the successful acquisition of the Cube Truck.
