**WHEREAS:** LMG passed Order in Council 2676, dated September 23, 2001, outlining their commitment to a food sovereignty initiative.

**WHEREAS:** Listuguj Community Garden has been in development and operation for 11 years and has formed a part of the food sovereignty program at Listuguj.

**WHEREAS:** the LMG accessed government funding from Canada Economic Development – Quebec (CEDQ) to advance the community garden project, which includes 2 greenhouses, a solar farm, office trailer, 2 storage containers, refrigerated container, and 2 water wells.

**WHEREAS:** the Funding Agreement with CEDQ is complete and new funding is required to complete the connection of the solar farm to the Hydro-Quebec power grid, the supply of electricity to the community garden buildings, expand the concrete slab for the refrigeration unit, grading and levelling of the site, and benching, for the estimated total remaining project cost of \$██████████

**WHEREAS:** it is feasible to proceed immediately with electrical connections to and from the Hydro-Quebec power grid and perform the remaining project tasks in the spring of 2025.

**WHEREAS:** Secrétariat aux relations avec les Premières Nations et les Inuit (SRPNI, formerly SAA), Quebec, has confirmed the costs for the project components described above are eligible for funding under the Indigenous Infrastructure Initiatives Fund (IIF) IV for up to 50 percent of their total cost, and core funding of the LMG Economic Development unit is available as a matching contribution to the project to fund 50 percent of the remaining project costs.
