WHEREAS: the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government ("LMG") has identified the need for housing-related infrastructure to support the development of 61 new residential lots on Atlantic Drive, including roads, storm and sanitary sewers, water distribution, and signage;

WHEREAS: the LMG has secured funding in the amount of [REDACTED] through the First Nation Infrastructure Fund (Stream 2: Housing) to support housing-related infrastructure;

WHEREAS: the LMG has also secured funding in the amount of [REDACTED] through the First Nation Infrastructure Fund (Stream 1: Extension of Infrastructure), to support the extension of essential infrastructure required for the development;

WHEREAS: funding under Stream 1 covers 80% of the total eligible cost of [REDACTED] with the remaining 20%, equivalent to [REDACTED] to be provided by LMG reserve funds;

WHEREAS: both funding agreements require formal acceptance and execution by the Listuguj Mi'gmaq Government in partnership with the Aboriginal Savings Corporation of Canada;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

1. Chief and Council authorize the Chief Executive Officer ("CEO") and the Capital & Infrastructure Directorate ("C&I") to formally accept the funding in the amount of [REDACTED] from the First Nation Infrastructure Fund (Stream 2: Housing);
2. Chief and Council authorize the CEO and the C&I Directorate to formally accept the funding in the amount of [REDACTED] under the First Nation Infrastructure Fund (Stream 1: Extension of Infrastructure), with LMG contributing 20% [REDACTED] of the total costs from its reserve funds;
3. Chief and Council authorize the CEO and the C&I Directorate to execute both funding agreements with the Aboriginal Savings Corporation of Canada on behalf of the LMG;
4. Chief and Council authorize the CEO to adjust the funding structure as needed to maximize use of the funds and prevent the return of any portion, provided that Chief and Council are kept informed of any such adjustments.
